

General Travel Information

DEPARTING FROM SYDNEY

PRE-FLIGHT COVID-19 PCR TEST

- You may be required to provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test prior to departure and/or pre-book tests to be taken following arrival at your destination, depending on the country you are travelling to.
- The testing requirements, including types of acceptable tests and documentation required, are set by the countries you are travelling to and transiting through.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- A valid International COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate from the Australian Government (retrieved from your Medicare Online Account or the Medicare mobile app). Your domestic Medicare proof of vaccination will not be accepted for international travel.
- A negative pre-departure COVID-19 test result, if required by the country you are travelling to or transiting through.
- Any other documentation applicable to your destination, including passenger declarations and entry forms.

UPDATE TO COVID-19 REGULATIONS

- From 21 June 2022, it is no longer mandatory for international travellers to follow certain rules including taking a COVID-19 test upon arrival in NSW.
- From 17 June 2022, travellers are no longer required to wear a mask in airports in NSW.
- From 9 September 2022, international flights travelling to Australia will no longer be subject to a mask mandate. Travellers are advised that the mask requirements of the airline you are travelling with or the country you are travelling through may vary.
