

Travelling to Sri Lanka

- <u>International Vaccination Certificate:</u> The requirement to produce a COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate upon arrival in Sri Lanka has been removed. However, it is recommended to keep the vaccination certificate in your possession during your stay in Sri Lanka to produce to medical personnel when and if required.
- <u>Testing Requirements</u>: The requirement to produce a pre-boarding or on-arrival negative COVID-19 test (PCR/RAT) upon arrival in Sri Lanka has been removed.
- <u>Visa:</u> If you are a foreign passport holder (i.e. do not hold a Sri Lankan Passport), you'll need a visa to enter Sri Lanka.

- <u>Health Declaration Forms:</u> A submission of a health declaration form is no longer required.
- <u>Digital Arrival and Departure Cards:</u> Sri Lanka has introduced <u>Digital Arrival & Departure Cards</u>, which shoul be completed three days prior to travel.
